## **7<sup>th</sup> ESOR** ACCOMODATION

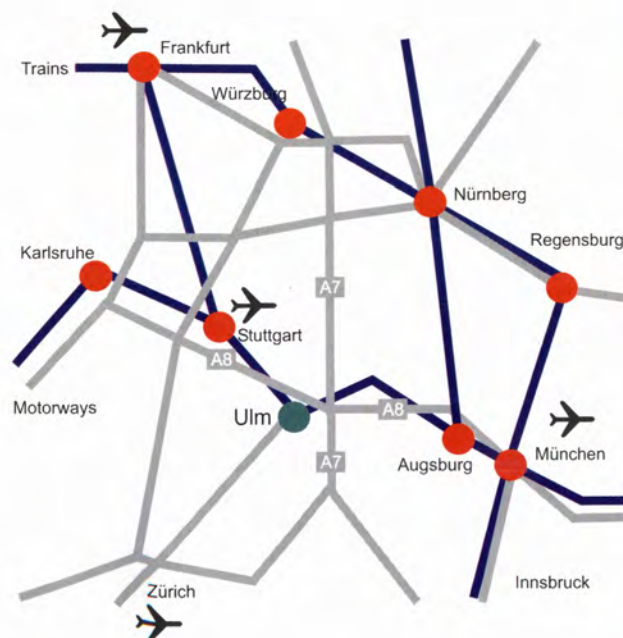
Accommodation will be available in hotels in the city of Ulm within 5 km of the University campus easily accessible by public transportation.
